- The reference model used in this mounting instruction is C 399.

### INSTALL MDC2 BLUOS-D

#### STEP A

Remove the MDC Classic cover and top cover by loosening and taking out the screws holding them in place.




#### STEP B




This PCB assembly includes static sensitive components, take appropriate precautions.

- 1 Take note of the unique Wi-Fi MAC address (the same can be found on the MDC2 BluOS-D metal back plate). This is needed when configuring the MDC2 BluOS-D.
- 2 Remove the protective tape from the contact terminals.
- 3 Slide MDC2 BluOS-D module through the rail pushing all the way to the corresponding connectors.
- 4 Make sure MDC2 BluOS-D module is locked in.



Use corresponding screws to fix back into place MDC2 BluOS-D module and top cover.

### BLUETOOTH AND WI-FI ANTENNA CONNECTIONS



Connect supplied Bluetooth antenna and Wi-Fi antenna\*

## DIRAC SETUP CONNECTION



Assemble together supplied MIC assembly and USB MIC Sound Adaptor and then connect to USB port of MDC2 BluOS-D.
